AGE DIVISIONS & REQUIREMENTS

Age as of August 31, 2018

LEADLINE YOUTH

Age 8 and under. May not enter other mounted classes.
Requires an adult to lead.

BEGINNER YOUTH

Limited to children who have never loped, cantered, or galloped in any competition & have not exhibited in any mounted point earning class prior to August 31, 2018. These classes will be walk/jog/trot only. Any gait other than walk/trot in the class will be cause for disqualification in that class.

NOVICE YOUTH

Limited to children who have not won more than two first places in any one particular class consisting of three or more riders prior to the show. In the case of a "Show Series," a rider will remain a NOVICE until the series ends regardless of how many first places have been won.

JUNIOR YOUTH - 13 years of age and under

SENIOR YOUTH - Ages 14-18

ADULT – 19 & over

LIMITED ADULT – Must have some type of limitation – such as new to the show arena, young horse, recent surgery; age 60 + who does not lope. **Those competing in Limited Adult may ride two-handed.** Once a competitor wins in this division, if they choose to stay in this division, they cannot win the Spring Series High Point until the 6th year.

FALL SHOWS

Show dates: September 1 October 6 November 3

Registration begins at 8:00 am; Show begins at 9:00 am

For all Halter Classes, you may pre-register. On the day of the show, books will open at 8am and close at 8:30 am. Otherwise, books will stay open for all other classes.

Trail will begin at 10am.

Formal show attire is not required. Short sleeves are acceptable. Boots and jeans are required.

SPRING SHOWS

Show dates: March 9 April 6 May 4 June 1

Registration begins at 8:00 am; Show begins at 9:00 am. Books will close for Halter classes at 8:30am.

Trail will begin at 10am.

Formal show attire is required. Long sleeved shirt, Western hat (optional for Speed), typical cowboy boots. All other footwear is prohibited. English classes require hunt seat jacket with hunt cap and English boots.

MUST SHOW IN TWO OF THE FOUR SHOWS TO QUALIFY

DAILY AWARDS

Rosettes for first through sixth places or \$ voucher

High Point Awards in RANCH, WESTERN & SPEED in applicable age divisions.

High Point Awards in English and In-Hand.

If you cannot stay to receive your award you will need to leave a signed note indicating who will pick it up for you. No note, no award.

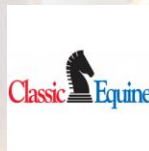
