# RULES

1. Rules and decisions of the JC4H Horse Committee supersede all others.
2. Management reserves the right to reclassify exhibitors.
3. High points will be figured on the six point system.
4. Youth exhibitors may show in only one age division. (*Beginner, Novice, Junior*) They may also show in an "open" event.
5. Exhibitors are limited to one category high point per show. **All must declare a category for tie breaker.**
6. a. Exhibitors may ride more than one horse, but points will be kept separately on each horse and exhibitor combination.  
6.b. **All rail classes, Showmanship and Horsemanship can be entered once per exhibitor. A second horse cannot be entered in any of these classes.**  
6. c. Competitors will use the same back number for entire series.
7. Adults will be allowed to ride in Adult and Limited Adult, but NOT on the same horse. When these exhibitors show in both divisions, only the horse shown in regular adult classes will be eligible for a daily high point.
8. "All Day Fees" apply to **each** horse/rider combination.
9. Entries close as the preceding class begins.
10. Protests must be in writing, accompanied by \$25 cash, filed with the show management immediately after the class.  
**Judges' decisions are final and cannot be protested.**
11. Minor exhibitors must have the signature of a parent or legal guardian before showing.
12. No refunds or substitutions.
13. No stallions over one year of age will be allowed on the grounds.
14. a. For safety, if a horse kicks up or is "annoyed" by others riding up behind it, a red ribbon shall be tied on its tail. If a judge or show management directs an exhibitor to use a red ribbon, the horse will be excused from participating until the red ribbon is in place.  
14. b. Management reserves the right to excuse any horse or person showing unsafe or objectionable behavior in the arena or on the grounds.
15. Timed events will run with the gates closed. Exhibitors will begin their run after the gate is closed.
16. Timed event exhibitors must enter the arena unassisted.
17. Training tack is not allowed in judged events.
18. Safety helmets are strongly recommended.
19. Riding two-handed in western and ranch judged classes in Novice, Beginner and **Limited Adult** is permitted without regard to bit type. Juniors, Seniors and Adults must ride one-handed in Western and Ranch judged classes when using a curb bit. They may ride two-handed when using a bosal or snaffle bit.
- 20. Proof of negative Coggins within the last year is required on all horses.**
21. Show management reserved the right to interpret rules. All decisions are final. 4H rules shall be used for guidelines.
22. "Crossover" entries from Western classes are permitted in Ranch Pleasure, Riding & Trail. Hoof black, tail extensions and banding are permitted.
23. All classes are "Western" and require Western tack unless otherwise noted.
24. Classes with \*s are non-point classes.
25. Exhibitors must show in a minimum of 3 classes of a category to be eligible for that category's high point.
26. Exhibitors may not be fastened in the saddle in any manner. Rubber bands permitted in speed events only.
27. Exhibitors must use a saddle that fits the rider. Does not apply to lead line.
