JOHNSON COUNTY 4-H HORSE PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

To receive a **Horse Project Completion Certificate**, the following requirements must be met:

1. The 4-H Club requirements to be a member in good standing must be met (attendance, participation, etc.).
2. The Horse Project Record Form for the current year must be **turned in by May 1** to the club manager.
3. Forms will be available on <https://johnsoncountyhorse.com/contact.asp#> under the Forms tab.
4. By the due date, members **with** a horse must participate in:
 - a. Two off-horse clinics or equine related classes
 - i. Examples: hoof care, dental, body work, medical care, KT Taping, etc.
 - b. One hands-on clinic with your horse
 - i. This could be an in-hand or in-saddle clinic
 - c. Exhibit at one horse show
 - d. List any off-horse activities you also participate in
 - e. Each of these clinics and/or shows need to be listed under the "Learning Experiences" & "Activities Completed per Project" sections of this form.
5. By the due date, members **without** a horse must have participated in:
 - a. Four off-horse activities such as:
 - i. Judging events
 - ii. Horse Quiz Bowl
 - iii. Hippology
 - iv. Mini clinics held by clubs
 - v. Volunteering at a Johnson County 4-H Horse Show
 - b. Each of these activities to be listed under the "Learning Experiences" & "Activities Completed per Project" sections of this form.
6. If you have more information to list or show than space is allowed for; add an additional hand-written or typed page to include the additional information.

The horse project may include one or all of the following types of projects and may involve more than one animal.

1. **Riding, Training, Management and Development:** Feeding, managing, or training - for sale purpose or using for experience gained in management and training as a project.
2. **Breeding and/or Production:** Animal bought or raised and used for breeding purposes.
3. **Horseless Projects:** Participation in Clinics, Horse Judging, Horse Bowl, Hippology teams.
