RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

Must be a current member of Texas 4-H and in good standing.

Must compete in the Senior Youth Division at the Johnson County 4-H Shows.

Points earned must be with one horse and one rider for all shows and classes (one back number).

Must win points in at least two disciplines. Points from all disciplines (excluding English) will be added.

(Western, Ranch, Speed, plus Showmanship – bonus points as usual)

Must attend a college, university or vocational school within 18 months of graduation from high school.

Also dual-credit eligible. This is for Spring. In Spring must compete in 3 of the 4 shows. The more shows you attend the more potential for more points.

Senior Youth Winner with the most points overall - \$1,500 Second place—\$500

Junior Youth Winner with the most point overall - \$250 cash

No need to apply, write an essay, or make a request. Points will be kept as usual and winners will be declared at the Awards Banquet to be held in the Summer.
