* All funds herein are provided by Johnson County Horse Committee (JCHC) for active Johnson County 4-H members and teams.

** All disbursements are dependent on the availability of funds from the JCHC and are provided solely according the Financial Best Practices of 4H. Funds are determined primarily by rider attendance and horse show profits.

Registration fees to attend horse educational program(s). The clinics must be relevant to equine topics, riding skills, and interests. The clinic should be sponsored by Texas A&M, Texas Tech, WTAMU, other college/university or a professional equine-oriented organization (AQHA, TQHA, APHA, NCHA, NRCHA, etc.).

Active Johnson County 4-H members

Allotted a **reimbursement** up to \$150 per 4H member, per 4-H year

Proof of payment **and** attendance will be required for reimbursement.

Includes Equine Ambassador, judging, quiz bowl and hippology camps.

If the clinic or sponsoring organization is not known to the Committee, a published brochure describing the event will be needed to determine relevance.
